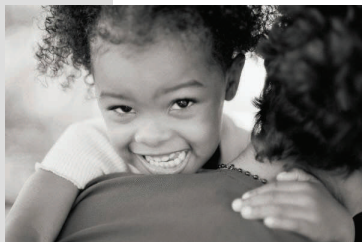

Currently, we have over 200 providers and, although that may seem a lot, we still have significant needs in the location of services as well as in the specialties offered.

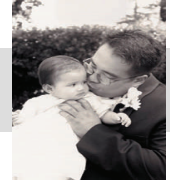
